REQUIREMENTS OF SAINT REPORT PROJECT

A. Select your Saint based on the information available on the internet and the libraries in Tinley Park, Orland Park and Religious Education office. Review the attached resource page for available saint resource information. Please be aware that there is often more than one saint with the same name. Look for clues (such as places lived, year of death, etc.) to make sure that you are not mingling more than one saint. While we ask you not to "Google" your saint, we do recommend good catholic websites, such as:

- B. You will be doing one Confirmation Saint's Name report:
- C. Complete the "Saint Fact Sheet" neatly and legibly. The "Saint Fact Sheet" will help you prepare your written Saint Report. <u>Staple the completed "Saint Fact Sheet" to your written Saint Report.</u>
 - 1. History of the Saint's life; birthplace, childhood, occupation,
 - 2. What miracles or special works did he/she perform?
 - 3. What type of hardships or persecutions did he/she have to endure? How was his/her Faith tested?
 - 4. How did he/she acquire the strength and courage to maintain and continue in their ministry?
 - 5. Why did you choose this Saint?
 - 6. How does this Saint relate to your life today?
 - 7. If this Saint was living today, what type of occupation, life-style, or ministry do you think they would be involved in?

- 8. Report needs to have a cover with a picture of the Saint (if available), or a symbol, or the Saint's religious crest.
- 9. The report must be neatly handwritten, typed or printed on computer and must be a minimum of 250 words.
- D. Format for the Saint Report
 - a. Cover Page needs to including the following information:
 - i. Your Name
 - ii. Saint's Name
 - b. Resource Page that includes a listing of the internet sites or library books used to complete the Saint Fact Sheet and the Saint Report.
- E. Parent's signature on report
