Dear Friends of Saint George,

Thank you for your consistent and loving support of our parish. These are difficult times for so many of us. Some give in to fear. We, as Christians, go forward in trust. As we present this year's Financial Report for fiscal year 2022 (July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022), I am filled with gratitude for you. This has been a busy year as we continue to create a new normal in the world, communities, families, and our parish. As some of our long-time employees moved into retirement, so we welcomed new members of our pastoral staff: Renee Beemsterboer, Business Manager; Jeanne Lassandrello, Director of Life-Long Formation; Kristen Maxwell, Director of Youth Ministry; and Deacon Tim Keating. Each of them have brought a new expertise and enthusiasm to Saint George.

There are other projects, more mundane but still important, that have been achieved this year. All lighting on the entire campus has been upgraded for more energy efficiency; continuing parking lot maintenance; removal of the old sign in front of church; school landscaping; security cameras, especially around the school and Adoration Chapel; ongoing technology upgrades for school staff and students; relocation of rectory water pipes to avoid future disasters as we suffered this winter; and the long-awaited repainting of our church steeple.

We are looking at other projects in the near future. Much of the landscaping around the parish needs attention. The gym floor is reaching its limit. Of critical importance is rebuilding our Music Ministry. After the disappointment we endured recently, I am more determined to find a Director of Music who will bring quality to the program and encourage prayerful talent in praise of God. It is better for us to take our time to find the right person than to simply settle.

As our fine Children's Faith Formation program teaches our young people, our Saint Vincent de Paul Society reaches out to those in need locally, and our youth ministry takes off, we are also in the process of starting a Men's Club and Women's Club for adults. We are working in tandem with neighboring parishes to create a Young Adult Ministry. Various prayer and study ministries grow and develop. And there is more to come!

All of this is possible because of your generous support and participation. Mass attendance has been consistently rising since January, up approximately 50% from a year ago. Our collections are currently running at about 96% of pre-pandemic levels. Our expenses have remained approximately what they were pre-pandemic. While we are blest with our endowment, we know we cannot rely on it to make up for future shortfalls in ordinary collections. That was never its intention. And it has taken significant dives in recent months. We need to handle our current challenges together, while planning for a long future. I hope you will prayerfully consider your role in keeping Saint George a vibrant source of joy and hope for our community. Thank you for your dedication, concern, and generosity.
