### A WORD FROM THE PASTOR



Getting back in the saddle is a bit of a challenge but it is a pleasure to be back home. By the time you see this, I will have been back for a week and a half but as I write it, it is only two days. The experience I had in Italy was amazing. The beauty of the country, art, architecture, food and people all came through. Though I was there for a month, the pace was dizzying. The program was dense with classes, tours, and conversation. I have to admit there

were days when I wasn't sure I could look at another church! I think in large part, that had to do with so much to see in each and every church we visited. And by the time I joined the group, Saint Peter's wasn't even on the list! That was one I went to on my own.

To really grasp the grandeur of these places, a person simply has to be there in person. Photographs just don't express the immensity and artistry of what the eye beholds. Plus, the very construction of these magnificence places is incomprehensible. So often, after the initial awe has worn off, the next question is, "How did they do that????" Considering how primitive the tools were and how little technology they had, only adds to the overwhelming sense of majesty. One thing that came clear over and over again was the deep faith many of these artists carried with them and motivated them. They did it to give honor and glory to God. And now, through the ages, we are still invited to share their wonder.

Aside from Rome, we visited Venice. We were very happy it wasn't flooded and not too crowded. Saint Mark's Church is probably the most awe-inspiring church I have experienced, even more than Saint Peter's in Rome. All the artwork is done in mosaic ---- millions of tiny pieces covering ceiling, walls and floors. All of it, magnificent art. The canals are everything you've heard (but they didn't smell bad at all!). There are no cars or bikes allowed in Venice. I even saw a DHL delivery being made ---- from a boat!

I was fortunate enough to make side trips to Amsterdam and Barcelona. In Amsterdam I came to a new appreciation of Van Gogh and learned about the Catholic Church having to go underground after the Protestants took over. One regret was I was not able to get into the Anne Frank home. Next time! In Barcelona, I saw the Gaudi Sagrada Familia Church. On first glance, it can look like a seaside sandcastle. But when you really look into it, it reveals amazing stories. Construction started in the 1880s and continues to this day --- and probably will continue into our grandchildren's lifetime!

If you're interested in seeing a bit of the trip, go to my Facebook page (FrPaul Seaman --- yes, that is how it is displayed) and see some phots and descriptions I wrote. Maybe it will inspire you to consider a trip to see some of the world's great art, created to give God glory!

Finally, I want to thank Fr. Tom, the deacons and the whole staff who worked so hard while I was gone. It is a gift to be able to leave the parish and know it is in good hands. Thanks to all who made it possible!




### SAINT GEORGE SCHOOL P.A.R.T.






