



PARISH UPDATE

Our fiscal year will end on June 30, 2023. First and foremost, a big "Thank You!" to everyone who so generously supports Saint George Parish. Each week we see more people in the pews. More ministries, such as the Men's and Women's Clubs are taking off. Our Children's Faith Formation and School, along with our Youth Ministry work to bring our young people closer to Jesus. Our Music Ministry is taking off, too. We have much to be grateful for!

We have also made significant improvements around our campus. We have installed security cameras (\$10,250); removed the old sign from the rectory lawn (\$3,100); roof repairs (\$7,500); rectory kitchen repairs (\$15,000 after insurance); energy saving light replacement (\$2,200); Sacristy restroom renovation (\$10,000) and church landscaping (\$14,000). Once the tall trees were taken down, it revealed the discoloration on the protective windows over our stained glass. This work will cost around \$24,000. These are just some of our tasks done and yet to come.

Like your own, the parish bills increase. Plus our Christmas and Easter collections both fell short of expectations by about \$14,000 combined. We saw smaller School enrollment and revenue. It is important that we pay all our bills in a timely manner. I am asking that each parishioner make a special donation to Saint George by June 30. The suggested amount is \$200 but that is different according to each person's circumstances. Some may be able to do more, some less. Either way, you will make a big difference for Saint George. For convenience sake, we ask that you use the blue envelopes in the packs. They are also available in church. Thank you for your loving generosity and dedication to Saint George.



RESPECT LIFE

ONE YEAR AFTER ROE V WADE OVERTURNED

June 24 is the one-year anniversary of the Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization decision by the U.S. Supreme Court that overturned the 1973 Roe v. Wade decision which legalized abortion nationwide. Over the last year at least 14 states have placed significant restrictions on abortion that prevent most abortions in those states. Another 12 states are in the process of passing more restrictive laws, currently have some restrictions in place, or are working to resolve legal cases that prevent such laws from taking effect. Thus, at least 26 states have responded to the Dobbs decision by moving toward more protection for preborn babies and their mothers. Unfortunately, that leaves 24 states with very limited or even virtually no laws to protect preborn babies, including Illinois. Abortion is effectively unregulated in Illinois. This status has encouraged Planned Parenthood to commit abortions at more of their locations, including recently adding distribution of the abortion pill RU-486 at their Orland Park location. Women are endangered by the unregulated environment for abortion in Illinois with no requirements for licensing, inspections, reporting of complications, etc.

Why take health risks? When it comes to spacing children, many couples are turning to Natural Family Planning (NFP). NFP is 100% free of harmful side effects and does not involve the use of any medications, drugs, or devices. Proper use of NFP offers 99% effectiveness in postponing pregnancy as well as in helping couples with normal or marginal fertility achieve a pregnancy.

Now you can learn Natural Family Planning without ever having to leave your house. Natural Family Planning classes are available online. All you need is a computer or iPad, and speakers. The course features presenters on a live video feed, and you can ask questions through a live chat feature. New virtual classes in English and Spanish begin monthly.
