

**The Transfiguration of the Lord**

What is Christianity finally about? These days if you ask almost anyone who doesn't know the Bible you'll probably hear an answer like this: "Being a good person" or "following the golden rule." No offense to the golden rule, but our faith is simply much stranger than that. This week's feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord is a luminous example of

this. Jesus becomes radiantly and overwhelmingly beautiful. The glory of God literally shines forth from His body and even His clothes. Here we see that Christianity is not mainly a moral system, but a relationship with God in Christ, one that finally makes human beings gloriously beautiful.

Now we can see our good and bad deeds in a new and de-centered way. Our morality isn't about a heaven or hell scorecard. It's about lives open (or closed) to transfiguration, lives capable of revealing the glory of God in Christ to the world. Spouses, children, friends, co-workers, priests, consecrated women and men, and so on — we are all called to let the beauty of Jesus make our lives beautiful, little by little. His beauty in us is the center of our faith.

Music Opportunities at Saint George

As we are getting set to start after a summer break, there are opportunities for you to get involved in the MUSIC MINISTRY here at Saint George. If you find yourself humming to the radio or singing in the shower, this may be something for you to pray about, asking the Lord to direct you in ways to help your parish, and thus the community.

Here are some possibilities to consider:



SAINT GEORGE CHOIR – The choir sings at the 9:30 AM Sunday Mass and select Holy Day Masses.

Rehearsals take place on Thursday evenings at 7:00 PM, basically from after Labor Day through Pentecost.



CHILDREN'S CHOIR – We will be starting a group for youngsters to offer praise too! Rehearsals are tentatively scheduled on Wednesdays (time TBD). The group might sing at a Mass perhaps once a month. Age

requirements would be third grade and up. (They should be able to comfortably read song sheets). We are asking for a minimum of eight participants. This is a work-in-progress – keep an eye on the bulletin.



RESURRECTION CHOIR – Good for those who would like to offer support to grieving families. This group will sing at funerals as a ministry for those who need

comfort in their time of sadness. There would be no rehearsals other than meeting before the funeral on that day to go over music. This would be good for retirees and people who can't commit to evening rehearsals or regular weekend Masses. The group would be contacted by email to announce when funerals will be.





Planned Giving

"This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." (Matthew 17:5)

Every day, we can listen to Jesus and give back the gifts he has provided to us. Please consider making a gift from your individual retirement plan (IRA) that benefits you and our parish. A qualified charitable distribution (QCD) allows individuals age 70½ or older to authorize their IRA administrator to make a direct transfer of funds from their IRA to qualified charities, tax-free.

There are three main benefits of giving with a QCD:

1. If you are 72 years old or older, the amount you transfer can satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution.
2. The amount transferred directly to charity does not generate taxable income, which may reduce your annual income level. This may help lower your Medicare premiums and decrease the amount of Social Security that is subject to tax.
3. Your gift will be immediately used, allowing you to see the impact of your gift now.

Prayer Vigil in Orland Park

Please plan to join a prayer vigil to be held at Orland Park Planned Parenthood. We will gather along the public sidewalk extending from 14470 LaGrange Road in Orland Park. This vigil will take place from 3:00 PM to 4:00 PM on Monday, August 7. Parking is available in the Orland Chateau lot (14500 S. LaGrange Road), but please park in the back.

Even if you can only stop by for a short time, please join us. Show your concern to protect our teenagers from Planned Parenthood. Pray for the conversion of Planned Parenthood's staff. Contrary to their claims, Planned Parenthood's birth control and sex education programs always lead to more unplanned pregnancies and more abortions, not less.

Pregnant, Need Help?

If you learn of a pregnant woman who is considering abortion, suggest that she call The Women's Center at 708-425-0707 (Evergreen Park), Aid for Women at 312-621-1100 (Flossmoor and downtown Chicago), PASS Pregnancy Care Center at 708-614-9777 (Tinley Park and South Holland), or Southside Women's Services at 708-229-0092 (Evergreen Park), depending on the location that would be more convenient. If there is a change of heart after taking the abortion pill, call 877-558-0333 or go to AbortionPillReversal.com. There may still be time to save your pregnancy.


Collaborative Creative Research Project at Saint George

Feast of the Transfiguration


The disciples were afraid, but Jesus came and touched them, saying, "Rise, and do not be afraid."






