

A Word From The Pastor



This weekend we welcome home Deacon Tim Berryhill. Deacon Tim is on his way to ordination to the priesthood for the Archdiocese of Chicago. Tim was received into the Church at Saint George, after he was inspired by a friend of his to consider Catholicism. Since then, Tim's vocation has blossomed, and we continue to pray for him and his classmates as they prepare for priesthood ordination in May. As we support him in prayer, we are invited to support the seminary in the second collection. Please help as we seek to form more men into the priesthood as God calls. Welcome, Tim!

Last Saturday, we blest the new ambry. It is the cabinet in which is stored the holy oils used in Baptism, Confirmation and the Anointing of the Sick. These oils are blest by the Cardinal during Holy Week and from large vats, the oil is distributed to all the parishes. It is a beautiful sign of our unity. The ambry and the holy water fonts are from Saint Lawrence O'Toole Church, which closed. Since acquiring the fonts, we have had them refinished to a beautiful luster. It is an honor for us to be able to use these holy items at Saint George.

Aside from the holy water fonts, we have also had other items refinished. These include the processional cross, server candles and candelabra used in Eucharistic Adoration. We plan to refinish the two remaining fonts near the front exit, the thurible used for incense at funerals and other important occasions, and the holy water buckets. It takes almost twenty weeks for the work to be done! But as you can see, the results are stunning.

All of this work is made possible by your generous support of the Annual Catholic Appeal. Two years ago, I asked that we support the Appeal so we could do our part for the Archdiocese and raise additional funds for new vestments. Your support was so strong, we bought vestments and were able to have these items refinished. This year's Appeal is going towards the refreshed landscaping around the church and the new protective glass on our church. Now our stainedglass windows look exceptional!



Flossmoor 40 Days for Life Vigil

Please join the 40 Days for Life vigil at Planned Parenthood in Flossmoor on any Thursday from September 28 through November 2. These are known abortion days so Saint George Pro-Life is encouraging on-site prayer on these days for the victims of abortion. Saint George will focus on 10:00 AM to 11:00 am, but choose any hour from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM to pray on site at the Planned Parenthood abortion facility at 19831 S. Governors Highway in Flossmoor, Illinois. This vigil is part of the national call for 40 days of prayer and fasting for an end to abortion running from September 27 through November 5, and is one of over 500 locations in 30 nations. During these 40 days, please make an extra effort to pray and fast for the end of abortion in our nation (e.g. make extra visits to Holy Family Chapel and/or attend weekday Mass). Public parking is available 1/2 block north of the Planned Parenthood site on 198th St. which goes west from Governors Hwy., or along the alley that runs east from Governor's Hwy. behind the Vollmer Road strip mall (parking spots facing Planned Parenthood). Life Chain 2023

Life Chain Sunday is coming on October 1. Life Chains will again form on sidewalks across the US and Canada in over 1,900 cities and towns. Standing publicly, Christians will create a silent, loving protest against abortion. 


