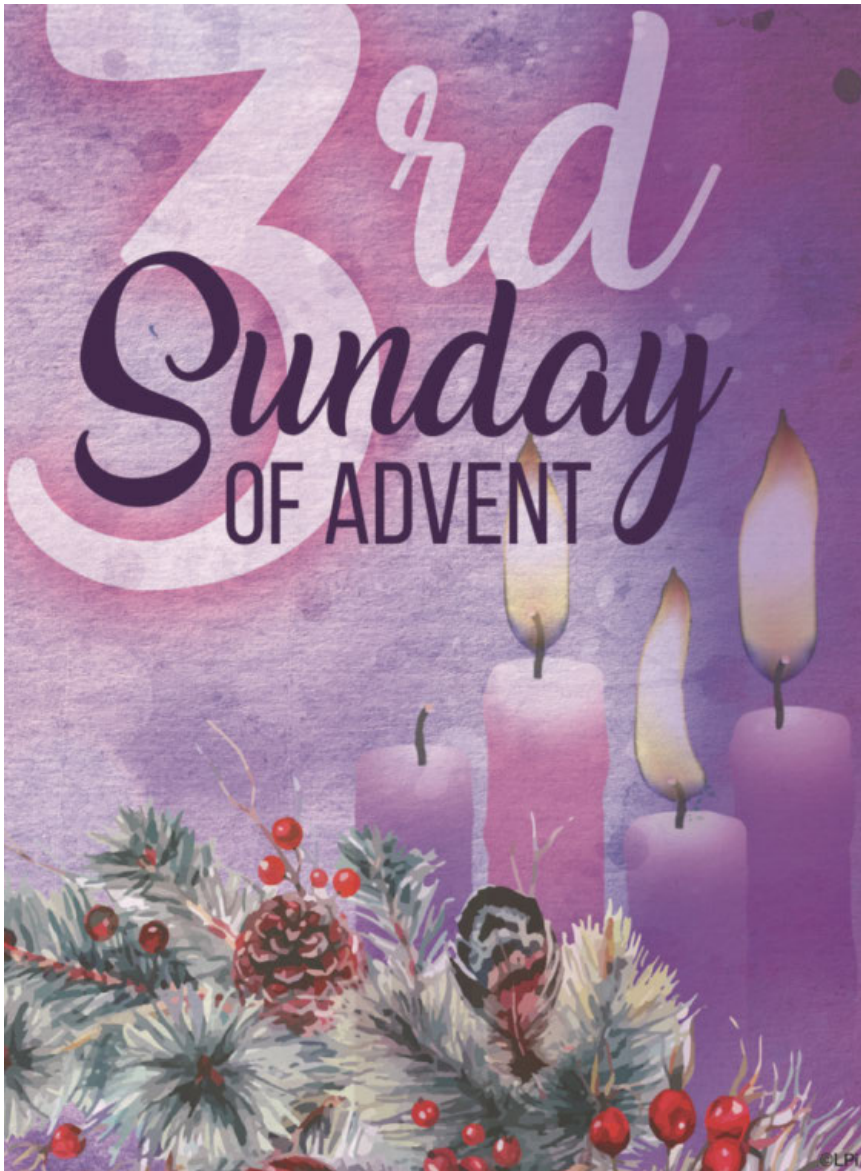

Our Advent Season of preparation is rapidly giving way to the great day of Christmas. The calendar has our celebrations a bit jumbled, so here goes: Next weekend is the Fourth Sunday of Advent. We will have a full schedule of weekend Masses as usual. But Sunday is December 24, Christmas Eve, so we will have Masses at 3:00 PM, 5:00 PM and 10:00 PM. So, it's a very full day! Christmas Day, Masses will be offered at 7:30 AM, 9:30 AM and 11:30 AM. So it will be a full weekend at Saint George!

In the meantime, on Wednesday, we will be offering a Parish Reconciliation Service at 7:00 PM. As we have been called to prepare for the coming of Jesus at Christmas and at the end of time, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is an ideal way to open the door of our hearts to the Prince of Peace. Come for the cleansing grace of God's forgiveness.

## Advent Reconciliation

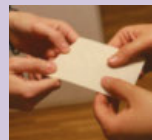


Saint George Parish Advent Reconciliation will be held on Wednesday evening, December 20 at 7:00 PM.

## Saint George Pro-Life

### Abortion and Women's Health

Abortion is obviously a traumatic experience from which women can suffer great emotional and psychological stress.

Post abortion research conducted by the Elliot Institute reported its survey of women eight weeks after they had undergone an abortion. Forty four percent complained of nervous disorders, thirty six percent said they experienced sleep disorders, thirty one percent said they regretted their decision and eleven percent admitted they had been prescribed psychotropic drugs by their doctor.

Research also shows that abortion can lead to infertility, by increasing the risk of miscarriages and ectopic pregnancy. It seems evident that a woman's biological body was not made by God to withstand the abortion procedure.

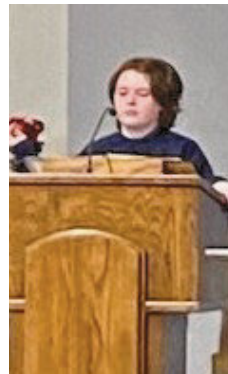

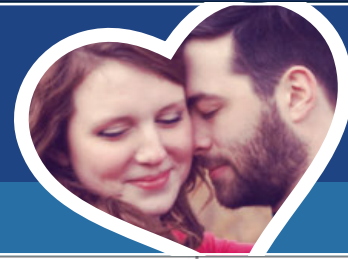
