

## MESSAGE FROM FATHER PAUL



Family reunions are always great. Getting together with people we love, catching up with those we haven't seen in a while, and perhaps, patching things up too. It's good to be together and to remember who we are, and where we've come from.

That's a bit how I feel about the semi-annual Chicago Priests' Convocation which is taking place this week.

We will hear some talks, spend time in prayer and share good time together. And though Chicago isn't really all that big, the distance between connections can sometimes be long. The fraternity of the priesthood is one that is often unknown by the laity and too often unappreciated by us priests. And while it is critical to have lay friends who remind us of the more typical challenges of life (e.g., marriage, jobs, raising a family, caring for sick relatives, etc.), we priests have our own unique challenges too. So gathering around our bishop, Cardinal Cupich, and other priests can be a moment of unity, honesty and vision.

I will be away for the week, along with Father Ken. Father John will be staying behind to take care of family commitments. He will be here for Mass each weekday, except for Tuesday, when a prayer service will take the place of the daily Mass. I ask that you all pray for us priests as we will be praying for you, our people.

Speaking of family, we honor and thank all our fathers who mean so much to us. Every family is unique and a father's role cannot be underestimated. The days of simply being a "good "provider" (supporting the home, paying the bills) are over. Now fathers have a much bigger role to play, and hopefully, a richer one. Thanks to all the great men who have shown us a father's love and care.

Just a few reminders: your chance to purchase a commemorative brick for our Marian Shrine is running out. Please get your orders in by June 24. These bricks are a beautiful way to remember a deceased loved one, or honor a person, a veteran or an important date in your life, like an anniversary.... ## **CANTORS WANTED!**



Saint Augustine said that if you sing, you pray twice!

My previous recruitment article for Music Ministry was to add a few more names for the Resurrection Choir to sing at funerals. A few of you came forward! Thank you so much!

What does a song leader/cantor normally do? Announce songs to invite all to sing, sing the verses of the psalm and gospel acclamation, and the Alleluia!

I know it makes some people nervous, to sing in front of others. I was too when I started! But please know that if you would like to help out, but don't want to "solo", we can do that. You can sing with me from the organ area. I won't make you solo if you don't want to, but maybe we could work toward that. We can still use your help.

We can rehearse before Mass or during the week. I usually send recording links via email for people to listen to from home. If you have someone to sing with (spouse, sibling, neighbor, friend, whoever), we can have more than one person at a time.

You do not need to join the choir, but of course you can. If you sang, or currently sing, in your high school or college choir (even if a long time ago), if you enjoy music in general, or if you find music an important part of your liturgical prayer, please talk to me. 
