plenty to talk about! This past week, our terrific school staff came together after a beautiful summer to begin work on the 2024-2025 school year. All summer our Cracker Jack maintenance crew has worked hard to make our school shine. Under the leadership of Mrs. Pratl, our principal, I look forward to another outstanding year. Wednesday of this week, the school bell rings for the first time this year and we are off and running! There is still time to register your child if you're looking for an exceptional Catholic educational experience.

Our Children's Faith Formation sessions begin on September 11. Mrs. Lassandrello, Director of Life-long Formation and her team have created a new curriculum for this year focusing on the Mass. Thank you to everyone for your support. The shrine will be blessed after the 7:30 AM Mass on Sunday, August 25, the Sunday immediately following the Feast of the Queenship of Mary.

But wait! There's more! Don't forget to make your reservation for our 90th Anniversary Dinner-Dance on Sunday, September 22 at the Orland Chateau. It will be an evening filled with music, friendship and celebration. Please plan on coming and being a part of these festivities. I am very grateful to the committee who initiated all our exciting 90th Anniversary events.

One of my top priorities has been creation of an engaging Teen Ministry. In pursuit of that, Saint George is teaming up with Saint Elizabeth Seton and Saint Stephen to create a tri-parish teen ministry. More details will be coming soon.

## Adult Choir

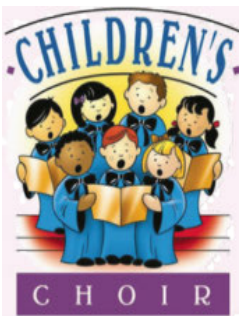
Saint George's music ministry will be starting the adult choir again, after a restful summer break! You are very much invited to join, serving God and your parish through singing.

## CANTORS WANTED!

Saint Augustine said that if you sing, you pray twice!

What does a song leader/cantor normally do? Announce songs to invite all to sing, sing the verses of the psalm and gospel acclamation, and the Alleluia!

I know it makes some people nervous, to sing in front of others. I was too when I started! But please know that if you would like to help out, but don't want to "solo", we can do that. You can sing with me from the organ area. I won't make you solo if you don't want to, but maybe we could work toward that. We can still use your help.

We can rehearse before Mass or during the week. I usually send recording links via email for people to listen to from home. If you have someone to sing with (spouse, sibling, neighbor, friend, whoever), we can have more than one person at a time.

You do not need to join the choir, but of course you can. If you sang, or currently sing, in your high school or college choir (even if a long time ago), if you enjoy music in general, or if you find music an important part of your liturgical prayer, please talk to me. 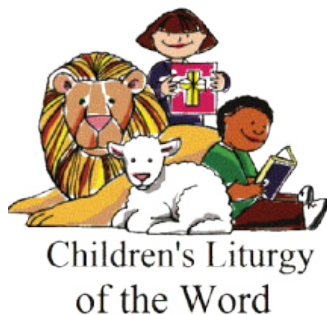

### CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

Children's Liturgy of the Word will resume on Sunday, September 1 at the 9:30 AM Mass.

Each week, during the 9:30 AM Mass, a volunteer catechist offers a lesson based on the scripture readings for that Sunday with special preference given to the Gospel. The children are dismissed from Mass prior to the Liturgy of the Word with a blessing, and return to share in the celebration of the Eucharist with their families.

Children's Liturgy of the Word was designed to help children from kindergarten through fifth grade get a better understanding of the Gospel message and how it relates to their lives. It is a wonderful program that brings kids together and allows them an opportunity to explore their faith and ask questions in an open discussion format. 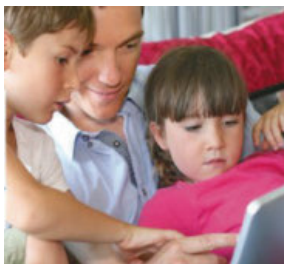

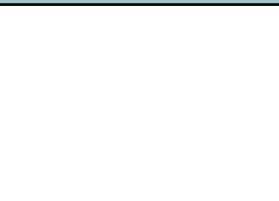
