

# Message from Father Paul



This is a story of two very different anniversaries. If you missed it, I highly recommend you watch last Sunday's "60 Minutes" program. The entire show

was remembering the tragedy and the heroism of that fateful day, September 11, 2001. It is a powerful presentation, telling the stories of the firefighters who ran into the burning towers in an effort to save lives. There were interviews with surviving firefighters, their families, and some of the children of those who died who later became firefighters themselves. They also included audio recordings of 911 operators who stayed on the phone with desperate people, trying to give them hope in a hopeless situation.

It was hard to watch but I thought I needed to because it is too easy to allow these events to simply become a bad memory. The show highlighted the extreme sacrifices that were made by people who certainly knew with each step they took up, they diminished their chances of coming down.

So these are days to give special tribute to police, firefighter, medical and military personnel. We also need to honor the many other people who help in a crisis --- 911 operators, doctors and nurses, and so many others who live out crises every day. They may not be as horrible in scope but, tragic and heroic just the same.

On a much brighter note, next Sunday we will celebrate the 90th anniversary of the founding of Saint George Church. Festivities will start with the 11:30 AM Mass, followed by an informal reception in the Meeting Rooms in the Parish Life Center. Then we go to the Orland Chateau for a Dinner-Dance where we will honor our former Director of Operations, Darlene Georges; our former principal, Ed Weston; and our former eighth grade teacher, Marge Pries. We are still accepting reservations until this Monday. I hope we will have a great crowd for food, music, raffles and friends. \$100 split-the-pot tickets are still available. Only fifty will be sold with a jackpot as much as \$2,500 if all tickets are sold. There will be lots of great things happening and I hope YOU will be there. So bring your joy and fun attitude and enjoy a great day as we wrap up our 90th anniversary celebration!

Saint George has entered into a joint ministry aimed at our teens. Anyone who is in 8th grade through senior year in high school is welcome and encouraged to join the events. On Sunday, September 29 at 4:30 PM, Saint Elizabeth Seton will host a Mass and Meal for all our teens and their families. Registration is required. See the notice in today's bulletin for more info.


