 topic for the first three months is:

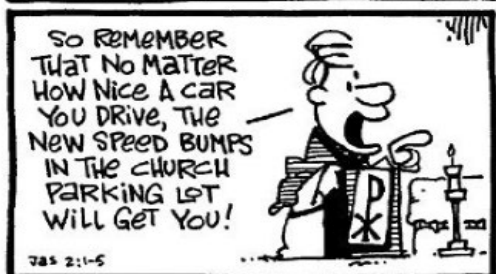
September 18: Music, Gathering Rite, Processional
