Psalm 16: The Path of Life - Scott Soper

refrain: You will show me the path of life, the delights that await me in your presence. Without you there is nothing; no joy can be complete until at last I sit by your side.

- 2. I bless the Lord who guides me even in my sleep; my face is turned to God. With the Lord at my side I shall stand firm.
