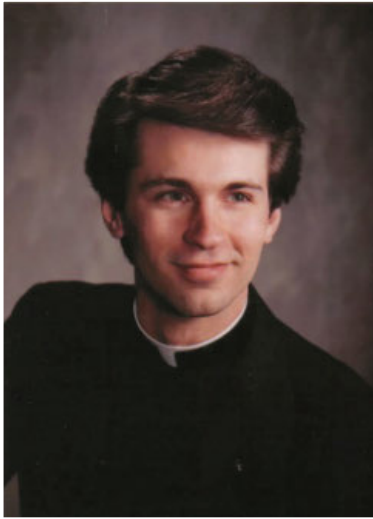

2025 as we welcomed Pope Leo XIV as our new Holy Father! Who would have thought we would have an American pope? A Chicagoan pope? A South Sider pope? What a joy for all people!

And wasn't it nice to get a break from all the Washington craziness? It seemed that all the news broadcasters we listened to were sharing in the joy and excitement of the moment. They were respectful and interested. It was as if the whole world had joined the Catholic Church from the death of Pope Francis to the introduction of Pope Leo.

It reminded me of the communal world we live in and how we've lost some of that. Growing up, if there was a special TV show or event on TV, you had to watch it right then or you were out of luck. The next day people would talk about it among friends, at work, in the grocery line (think The Beatles on The Ed Sullivan Show). It was

a common experience shared at the same time. We got a taste of that again with the white smoke pouring out of the chimney. It seemed like everyone was focused on God's action in the Church. What a blessing. May God bless Pope Leo XIV!

This weekend, Father John and I are celebrating our anniversary of ordination: Father John, twenty-one years, and me, forty. Protect Pollinators

Bees, butterflies, and other key pollinators are necessary for most of our major food crops. Honey bees pollinate 80 percent of all flowering plants alone, including more than 130 types of fruits and vegetables. According to Farmers.gov, the ecological service provided by pollinators is valued at \$200 billion each year.

Unfortunately, bee populations have dropped alarmingly across North America, as have the populations of many other pollinator species. They are in serious decline due to exposure to parasites, pesticides, disease, habitat loss and other environmental contaminants.

If we all dedicate just a small area to protecting habitats for pollinators, using native plants and sustainable gardening practices, we can help safeguard our common home. Limit pesticide use and consider following these tips to start your own pollinator garden at:

Spare Change Saves Babies

Baby bottles are still available at the exits of church. You are asked to save your spare change in the bottle. Your spare change will add up to help support the work of the Women's Center. Just put your extra coins in the baby bottle and return it to church on the weekend of June 21-22.

The Women's Center is a pregnancy resource center that helps mothers who might otherwise make the tragic choice of abortion. They offer real choices to women facing pregnancy under difficult circumstances. The Women's Center assists many abortion bound women every year, leading to a decision in favor of life for many babies each year.

Pregnant, Need Help?

If you learn of a pregnant woman who is considering abortion, suggest that she call The Women's Center at 708-425-0707 (Evergreen Park), Aid for Women at 312-621-1100 (Flossmoor and downtown Chicago), PASS Pregnancy Care Center at 708-614-9777 (Tinley Park and South Holland), or Southside Women's Services at 708-229-0092 (Evergreen Park), depending on the location that would be more convenient. If there is a change of heart after taking the abortion pill, call 877-558-0333 or go to AbortionPillReversal.com. There may still be time to save your pregnancy.

If you (or a person you know) needs to talk to someone to seek reconciliation and healing from an abortion, people are available who are ready to help you. Please call Project Rachel at 888-456-HOPE (4673), Post-Abortion Hotline at 800-5-WE-CARE, or Rachel's Vineyard at 877-467-3463.

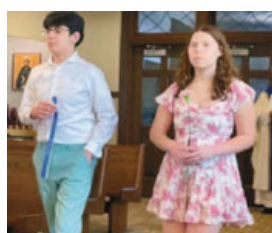

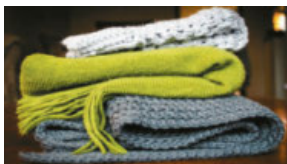

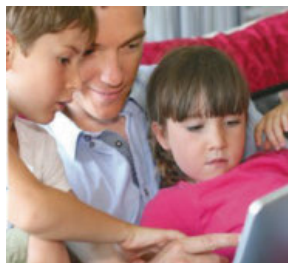
The Saturday 4:00 PM Anticipated Mass is live streamed on Facebook, then posted to the parish webpage and YouTube.
