

MESSAGE FROM FATHER PAUL



Words fall far short in describing Father John's and my feelings after last weekend's celebration for

our anniversary of ordination. We are both filled with gratitude and appreciation for the heartfelt affection we felt. Our families are both so appreciative of Saint George's support for us. The many gifts and messages of kindness and prayers are a blessing. Thank you so much.

This week I will be at Mundelein Seminary with some of the members of my ordination Class of 1985. There were twenty-one of us ordained from many dioceses, ten of us for Chicago. Since then, two have left active ministry and one died in a car accident. The rest of us are in varying degrees of ministry as health allows. We hope to spend these days reflecting on our ministry, the impact we have felt from the People of God, and how He has used us as His instruments. I'm looking forward to these days. Please pray for us and for more vocations to the priesthood.

This weekend, we honor those who gave their lives for our country with Memorial Day. Though it is sometimes reduced to the unofficial beginning of summer and a day for barbeques and parties, we cannot allow ourselves to forget that we can enjoy such times only because of the sacrifices made by brave men and women in our armed services. Our history is filled with wars and those who fought them. We have many inspiring stories of heroes who gave that "last full measure of devotion" as Lincoln said at Gettysburg. There are more who went off to war to protect our freedoms and came back, often with scars seen and unseen. Many of our families have our own heroes. We honor them. We honor the famous, people like John McCain, who spent five torturous vears as a POW in Viet Nam. Or Milton Olive of Chicago, who threw himself on a live hand grenade, sacrificing himself but saving four fellow soldiers. Perhaps you have some of your own heroes. Let's honor them today and every day.

I think Memorial Day is also a time for us to evaluate how we honor our veterans, especially how we care for those with physical or psychological battle wounds. Too many of these heroes are living in the streets. Some are even being deported. We can never allow ourselves to forget them. Ever.



WAYS TO GIVE

Our parish community is blessed to have such generous and faithful parishioners. Your contributions to the campaign will support important parish initiatives and support broader Church initiatives such as spiritually renewing our parishes, supporting our priests, and assisting vulnerable communities.

When considering a gift right for your family, know there are several ways you can give to the campaign. Donors who pledge may determine payment schedules to meet their own charitable or tax needs over five years.

Check: Parishioners should mark "Check" as the method of giving, select a payment frequency and fill in a start date on the pledge form. Payment reminders will be mailed to homes according to the frequency preference.

Credit Card and Automatic Bank Withdrawal: Parishioners should mark "Credit Card" or "ETF" as the method of giving, select a payment frequency and fill in a start date on the pledge form. Parishioners will need to provide appropriate credit card or banking information based on preferred automatic payment.

Stock and Securities: Parishioners should mark "Gift of Stocks and Securities" as the method of giving on the pledge form. The archdiocese will liquidate the shares as soon as possible and credit the campaign with the net of the sale, minus any brokerage fees. Donors must complete and submit a Letter of Intent to the archdiocese via an online form to identify the shares being transferred. Please call 312-534-7461 for more information and assistance.

Qualified Charitable Distribution from IRA: Parishioners should mark "Qualified Charitable Distribution from IRA" as the method of giving on the pledge form. This method allows individuals 70½ or older to authorize their administrator to directly transfer funds annually from their individual retirement account (IRA) to qualified charities, tax-free. If you are 73 or older, the amount you transfer can satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution. Please call 312-534-7959 for more information and assistance.

Donor Advised Fund: Parishioners should mark "Other" as the method of giving on the pledge form. A representative from the archdiocese will be in contact with parishioners directly regarding the pledge.

Planned Gifts: Parishioners should mark "Planned Gift" as the method of giving on the pledge form. Bequests, charitable gift annuities, and life insurance policies are just a few options for making long term commitments to the church. Please call 312-534-5404 for more information and assistance.

Matching Gifts: Parishioners should mark "Matching Gift" as the method of giving on the pledge form. Many companies have matching gift programs, enhancing employee's charitable contributions. This vigil will take place from 3:00 PM to 4:00 PM on Monday, June 2. Parking is available in the Orland Chateau lot (14500 S. LaGrange Road), but please park in the back.

Even if you can only stop by for a short time, please join us. Show your concern to protect our teenagers from Planned Parenthood. Pray for the conversion of Planned Parenthood's staff. Contrary to their claims, Planned Parenthood's birth control and sex education programs always lead to more unplanned pregnancies and more abortions, not less.

Natural Family Planning Classes Available Online

Why take health risks? When it comes to spacing children, many couples are turning to Natural Family Planning (NFP). NFP is 100% free of harmful side effects and does not involve the use of any medications, drugs, or devices. Proper use of NFP offers 99% effectiveness in postponing pregnancy as well as in helping couples with normal or marginal fertility achieve a pregnancy.

Now you can learn Natural Family Planning without ever having to leave your house. Natural Family Planning classes are available online. All you need is a computer or iPad, and speakers. The course features presenters on a live video feed, and you can ask questions through a live chat feature. New virtual classes in English and Spanish begin monthly.
