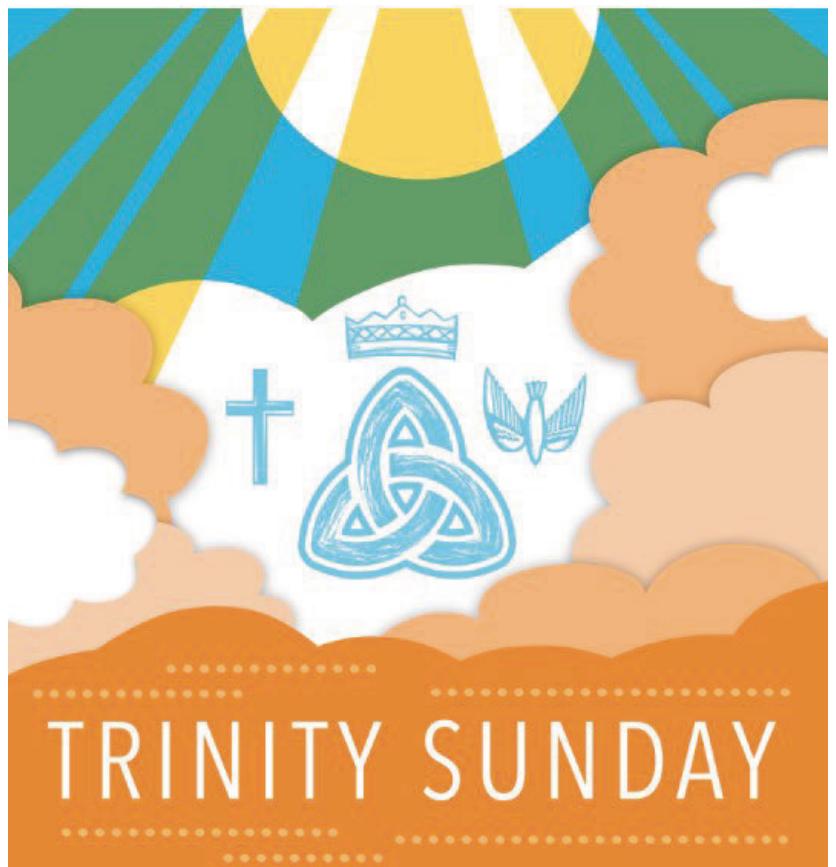

MESSAGE FROM FATHER PAUL

One of the jokes in the seminary was if anyone ever asks you a question you can't answer, just say, "It's a mystery!" Often

enough that's a pretty good answer. There are things we believe but are difficult to explain. Saint Augustine said, "Seek not to understand that you may believe, but believe that you may understand."

Dwelling in mystery, taking that huge leap of faith, is part and parcel of our Catholic Faith. And I think that every time we come to Mass, hear the Word and experience the Eucharist, we are essentially saying, "I'm OK with that. I choose to believe that I may one day understand." That is a choice that somehow ---- even mysteriously! --- gives meaning to our lives.

We believe there is a life after death. We believe there is a God. We believe Jesus is Our Savior. We believe everything will work out in the end, even if "the end" means in the next life. We believe that love conquers all.

We also believe in the Holy Trinity. We have one God who is revealed to us as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. But aren't they different? Yes! But they are the same. Right! How can two opposites be true at the same time? That's a great question! And you know the answer. It's a mystery.

We also honor all our dads on this Father's Day. We pray for all the

men who have shown us a strong, loving hand. The guidance of a father makes a world of difference to a child. Having two loving parents present in their lives is a blessing that continues well into adulthood. Thank you, dads! You make a difference every day!

This weekend, we will have an opportunity to make our pledges to the Generation to Generation campaign. You've been hearing about this for quite some time. Many of you have made your pledge, and I am very grateful. Our goal is \$1,120,000 to be fulfilled over the next five years. We are well on our way, but this weekend will be important to help us reach the finish line.

Half of all funds raised will go to the Archdiocese. This money will be used to strengthen struggling parishes, develop spiritual programs in the parishes, and support priests, from the seminary to professional development to retirement.

The money that remains at Saint George will be directed to safety issues: our parking lot which is deteriorating and the church fire suppression system. We must do these. If we raise enough, we will look into air conditioning the classrooms in our school and strengthening our fine arts program. We want to expand our children's sense of culture and help them grow into good citizens.

AL-ANON

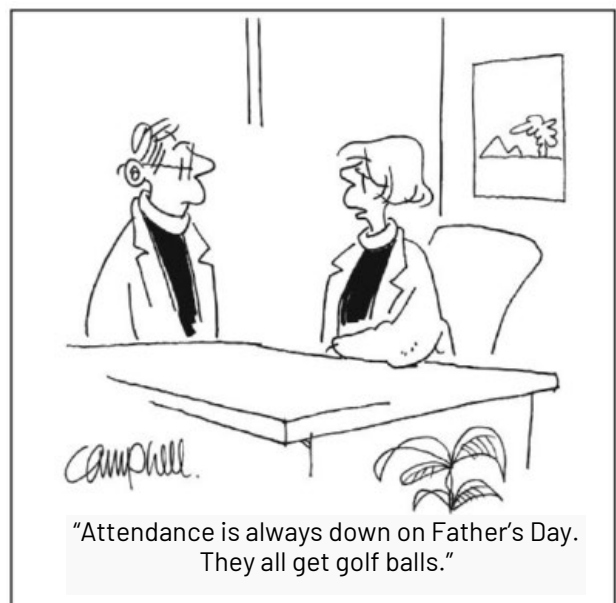

cards to enroll your Father are available at the exits of the church. Please fill out the enrollment envelope and place it in the collection basket this weekend.





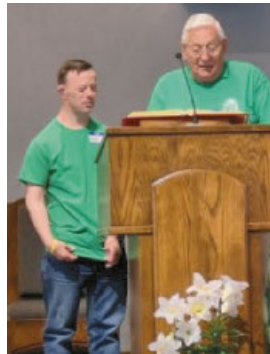
SPRED

This summer, we will be offering Altar Server Training for students entering fourth grade and up. Students must be Catholic and able to receive the Eucharist to serve in this ministry.



This is a fantastic opportunity for our children to serve their parish community. It is also a great way to learn more about the Mass and participate in a unique way. We become disciples of Christ when we follow His request "Feed my sheep." That is what service is all about.

Training will be held at 3:30 PM on June 17 and June 19; and at 12:00 PM on June 21. Training usually takes about an hour and students are expected to attend at least three sessions.

Online registration is available for trained altar servers to access and enter their available times and dates each month. When your child has completed the training and feels comfortable, we will have him/her paired with experienced servers for a time. Servers who feel they would like further training are welcome to join us.

GENERATION TO GENERATION WAYS TO GIVE

Our parish community is blessed to have such generous and faithful parishioners. Your contributions to the campaign will support important parish initiatives and support broader Church initiatives such as spiritually renewing our parishes, supporting our priests, and assisting vulnerable communities.

When considering a gift right for your family, know there are several ways you can give to the campaign. Donors who pledge may determine payment schedules to meet their own charitable or tax needs over five years.

Check: Parishioners should mark "Check" as the method of giving, select a payment frequency and fill in a start date on the pledge form. Payment reminders will be mailed to homes according to the frequency preference.

Credit Card and Automatic Bank Withdrawal: Parishioners should mark "Credit Card" or "ETF" as the method of giving, select a payment frequency and fill in a start date on the pledge form. Parishioners will need to provide appropriate credit card or banking information based on preferred automatic payment.

Stock and Securities: Parishioners should mark "Gift of Stocks and Securities" as the method of giving on the pledge form. The archdiocese will liquidate the shares as soon as possible and credit the campaign with the net of the sale, minus any brokerage fees. Donors must complete and submit a Letter of Intent to the archdiocese via an online form to identify the shares being transferred. Please call 312-534-7461 for more information and assistance.

Qualified Charitable Distribution from IRA: Parishioners should mark "Qualified Charitable Distribution from IRA" as the method of giving on the pledge form. This method allows individuals 70-1/2 or older to authorize their administrator to directly transfer funds annually from their individual retirement account (IRA) to qualified charities, tax-free. If you are 73 or older, the amount you transfer can satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution. Please call 312-534-7959 for more information and assistance.

Donor Advised Fund: Parishioners should mark "Other" as the method of giving on the pledge form. A representative from the archdiocese will be in contact with parishioners directly regarding the pledge.

Planned Gifts: Parishioners should mark "Planned Gift" as the method of giving on the pledge form. Bequests, charitable gift annuities, and life insurance policies are just a few options for making long term commitments to the church. Please call 312-534-5404 for more information and assistance.

Matching Gifts: Parishioners should mark "Matching Gift" as the method of giving on the pledge form. Many companies have matching gift programs, enhancing employee's charitable contributions. Contact your employer directly about its specific requirements and paperwork and assistance.

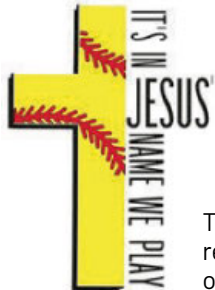

Assisted Suicide Bill Not Passed in Springfield

There is good news to report from the Illinois Legislature in Springfield. SB 1950 (alias for SB 9) did not get a final vote in the Illinois Senate. After SB 9 missed deadlines, SB 1950 (amends Sanitary Food Preparation Act) was hijacked in the Illinois House with the assisted suicide bill language and passed there. Fortunately, it did not receive a vote when returned to the Senate.

This dangerous bill would have allowed "medical assistance in dying" (assisted suicide) in the state of Illinois. It would allow doctors to prescribe lethal drugs to anyone diagnosed with a terminal illness. Doctors should not be asked to assist in suicide. Doctors need to have the trust of their patients. That trust would be threatened by assisted suicide.

WEEKLY STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION

Consider zero-waste options for picnics, BBQ and camping meals. Reusable items add a touch of class, sensibility and significantly reduce waste. Use lightweight reusable plates, utensils, bowls, cups and cloth napkins. Get creative with packaging. Reusable containers? Of course. What about Mason jar desserts? Go heavy on finger foods: cut vegetables and mixed nuts. Wipe off food when finished and use a washable cloth bag to hold used dinnerware for dishwashing later. Reserve a bag for recyclables and a container for compostables. If you must go disposable, use biodegradable paper products instead of plastic. Ditch the straws. Use a large thermos for drinks. 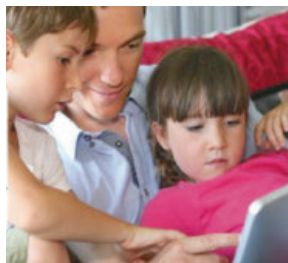
