The walls are transported to the home site where Habitat for Humanity will complete the house with other volunteers and skilled tradespeople.

Upon completion, the home will be dedicated to a family in need.

Oversee build crews. (Trained on Friday)

##### BUILDERS

Swing a hammer and pound some nails! Assemble the wall sections.

##### HOSPITALITY

Help plan, prepare, or serve food.

##### REGISTRATION

Help us register all of our wonderful volunteers.

##### CLEANERS / SAFETY

Assist with traffic flow. Help keep area neat and safe during and after the event.
