## THE CHALICE PROJECT - PRAY FOR VOCATIONS



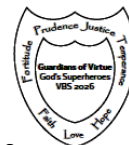
Saint George started the Chalice Project on Sunday, November 30. Each week at Mass, a family can volunteer to take the gifts to the altar during the Offertory.

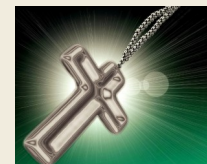

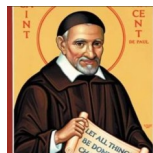
### PRAYER VIGIL IN ORLAND PARK
