

St. George Confirmation Saint Report Guidelines

Purpose

As part of your Confirmation preparation, you will choose a saint recognized by the Catholic Church whose life inspires you and whose example of faith you hope to follow. Your Confirmation saint should be someone you admire for their faith, virtue, and commitment to following Jesus.

Your report should teach others about your saint while explaining how your saint connects to your own faith journey.

Step 1: Choose Your Confirmation Saint

Select **one** saint recognized by the Catholic Church whom you feel connected to or admire.

Important: There are often several saints with the same name. Make sure you are researching the correct saint by checking details such as:

- Place of birth or where the saint lived
- Dates of birth and death
- Feast day
- Religious order (if applicable)

Please DO NOT simply Google your saint. Instead, use approved Catholic websites and other resources provided in class.

Step 2: Complete the Saint Fact Sheet

Complete every section of the Saint Fact Sheet neatly and thoroughly.

The fact sheet will organize your research and help you write your final report.

Staple the completed fact sheet to the back of your report.

Step 3: Write Your Saint Report

Your report should be written as though you are teaching your classmates about your saint and explaining how he or she has influenced your own faith journey.

Your report should answer the following questions:

A. History of the Saint's Life

Include:

- Birthplace
- Childhood
- Family background
- Education or training
- Occupation or vocation
- Important events during the saint's life

B. Miracles and Special Works

Describe:

- Miracles attributed to the saint
- Acts of charity
- Important accomplishments
- Ministry and service to others

C. Hardships and Challenges

Explain:

- Difficulties or persecution the saint endured
- How the saint's faith was tested
- Sacrifices made while serving God

D. Faith and Strength

Discuss:

- How the saint found courage and strength
- How faith in God helped the saint continue serving others

E. Personal Reflection

Explain:

- Why you chose this saint
- What you admire most about him or her
- Which Gifts of the Holy Spirit you see reflected in your saint
- How those gifts inspire your own faith journey

F. Connection to Your Life

Describe:

- How your saint relates to your life today
- Similar interests, talents, challenges, or goals
- What lessons you hope to learn from your saint

G. If Your Saint Lived Today...

Imagine your saint living in today's world.

What kind of:

- Occupation
- Lifestyle
- Ministry
- Service to others

would your saint most likely be involved in?

Step 4: Cover Page

Include:

- Student Name
 - Confirmation Saint's Name
 - Picture or drawing of your saint
- OR
- A symbol representing your saint if no picture is available

Step 5: Resource Page

Include all sources used to complete your report.

Examples:

- Approved Catholic websites
- Library books
- Church or parish resources

Step 6: Parent Signature

A parent or guardian must review your completed report and sign the Fact Sheet before submission.

Report Requirements

Your report must:

- ☐ Be 300–350 words
- ☐ Be typed
- ☐ Use 12-point Times New Roman font
- ☐ Be double-spaced
- ☐ Include a cover page
- ☐ Include a picture or drawing of your saint
- ☐ Include a resource page
- ☐ Have the completed Saint Fact Sheet attached to the back
- ☐ Include a parent/guardian signature
